FARA Europe's strategic priorities include unifying, consolidating, and supporting the Friedreich's Ataxia (FA) clinical infrastructure across Europe. Simultaneously, it aims to establish and support a global entity, the FA Global Clinical Consortium (FA GCC), with the goal of informing and accelerating the development of new treatments for FA.

FARA Europe will leverage existing resources and will seek additional financial support for the FA GCC's ongoing research and operating activities.

The budget for the FA GCC research activities will be distributed to the European clinical sites in the form of awards and grants to fund start up fees and clinical cohort visits included in the UNIFAI natural history study.
